




1. Take a 15x15 piece of redwood framed with 2x2's on three sides. Add three holes for drainage with screen to keep out bugs



3. Add platycerium mix with a time release fertilizer and 3 inches of sphagnum moss to opening on top



5. You need to cut a 3" hole in the center, through the fiber and screen, to create a cavity in soil for your 4 plant



2. Then staple palm fiber and plastic screen to 2x2's on the board



4. Water thoroughly from top note we added firring strips for more support and appearance



6. Once plant is placed in hole tie off with fishing line and to pack the soil in tap the board on the ground a few times then water thoroughly
