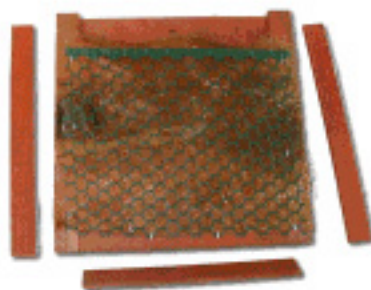

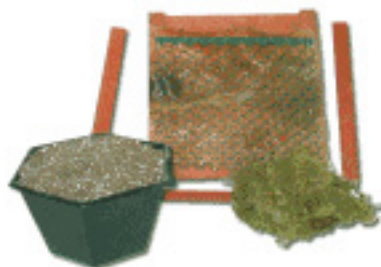

1. Take a 15x15 piece of redwood framed with 2x2's on three sides. Add three holes for drainage with screen to keep out bugs



2. Then stapled palm fiber and plastic screen to 2x2's on the board



3. Add platycerium mix with a time release fertilizer and 3 inches of sphagnum moss to opening on top



4. Water thoroughly from top note we added furring strips for more support and appearance



5. You need to cut a 3" hole in the center, through the fiber and screen, to create a cavity in soil for your plant



6. Once plant is placed in hole tie off with fishing line and to pack the soil in tap the board on the ground a few times then water thoroughly
